

## WEEKDAY ROSH CHODESH DAVENING GUIDE

All page numbers listed are for the Artscroll siddur.

### Overview of Changes In The Prayers For Rosh Chodesh

- ❖ Ya'aleh V'Yavo is inserted in every Shemoneh Esrei.
- ❖ Half Hallel is recited. (See below for details)
- ❖ Mussaf for Rosh Chodesh is recited.
- ❖ We do not recite Tachanun or Lamnatze'ach.
- ❖ We recite Psalm 104, Borchi Nafshi, at the end of the morning prayers.

### Detailed Guide to Changes for Rosh Chodesh

- **Ma'ariv:**
  - **Pages 256 – 282:** Standard weekday Ma'ariv is recited with one addition:
    - **Page 274:** Ya'aleh V'yavo is recited with the insertion for Rosh Chodesh.
- **Shacharis:**
  - **Through Page 52:** Standard Morning Prayers and Blessings with one addition:
    - **Page 42:** The sacrifice for Rosh Chodesh is read.
  - **Pages 54 – 96:** Weekday Pesukei d'Zimra, Blessings of Shema & Shema.
  - **Page 98 – 118:** Standard weekday Shemone Esrei is recited with one addition:
    - **Page 110:** Ya'aleh V'yavo is recited with the insertion for Rosh Chodesh.
  - **Pages 632 – 642:** Full Hallel is recited. (The four species are held and shaken.)
- **Torah Reading:**
  - **Pages 138 – 148:** When davening with a minyan, prayers for removing the Torah from the Ark on weekdays are recited.
    - Torah Reading: 4 aliyahs. Bamidbar 28:1-15
- **Mussaf:**
  - **Pages 152 – 156:** Ashrei and Uva L'Tziyon are recited.
  - **Pages 644 – 652:** Mussaf Shemoneh Esrei for Rosh Chodesh is recited.
    - **PLEASE NOTE:** The tefillin are removed prior to davening Mussaf.
- **Concluding Prayers:**
  - **Pages 158 – 168:** Aleinu and the Song of the Day for the day of the week.
  - **Page 172:** Psalm 104, Borchi Nafshi, is recited.
- **Mincha:**
  - **Pages 232 – 254:** Standard weekday Mincha is recited with these adjustments:
    - **Page 244:** Ya'aleh V'yavo is recited with the insertion for Rosh Chodesh.
    - Pages 252 – 254: Tachanun is omitted.
